

### **PROBLEMATIC**



According to a World Health Organization and UNICEF study, **2.1 billion** people, comprising 30% of the world's population, lack access to domestic water supply, while **4.4 billion** people, accounting for 60%, do not have access to safe sanitation infrastructure.

2, 1 Billions people don't have access to clean water.

Potable water, sanitation, and proper hygiene are essential to safeguard the health of every child and community. Every year, 361,000 children under five years old die from diarrhea, not accounting for the poor quality of sanitation infrastructure. Contaminated water fosters the transmission of diseases such as cholera, dysentery, hepatitis, and typhoid.





# Hydraulique Sans Frontières : Committed to improve Access to water

Founded in 1990, Hydraulique Sans Frontières is a non-profit organization specialized in the field of water and sanitation infrastructure. Through the construction of water supply systems and toilets, HSF significantly contributes to improve living conditions for local populations in the following countries: Senegal, Benin, Burkina Faso, Togo, Cameroon, Côte d'Ivoire, and Madagascar.

### Values

Humanism, solidarity, and partnership are the values that guide Hydraulique Sans Frontières in his mission. It is a secular non-profit organization that operates by adhering to professional ethics, an international spirit of solidarity, dynamic global development, and local laws and cultures compatible with universal values.

### Missions

HSF has two missions: In the South, to act on the Sustainable Development Goals through water and sanitation projects. In the North, to promote international solidarity.

### Actions

Hydraulique Sans Frontières promotes the autonomy of local populations in emerging countries. It acts upon the solicitation of local villages, primarily in rural areas, and supports projects in the following fields:

- Access to drinkable water
- Technical training
- Public water management services
- Sanitation infrastructure
- Development education




